• Offer more opportunities for students in school and in the community, while respecting family values.

• Not only offer a broader program of studies outside the core academic subjects, but promote the ones we currently support.

Ways To Improve:

- 1. Keep supporting teachers to work together on the new curriculum and on school-wide activities like "Wellness Fridays," STEAM programs, and resources.
- 2. Celebrate students' learning and progress in school.
- 3. Encourage parents to get involved in Parent-Teacher Interviews, student-led assemblies, volunteering, and completing surveys.
- 4. All staff will continue to build positive and meaningful relationships with students.
- 5. Keep addressing students' academic, social, and emotional needs. Connect students and families with resources for well-being and health.
- 6. Show an inclusive philosophy, focussing a sense of belonging and appreciation for diversity.
- 7. Maintain regular communication between teachers, administration, parents, and the student support team to make sure the right support is in place and to plan for the next steps.
