5. Carmangay Principal Report

- Staff Intros + Pictures
- Central Office In Carmangay
 - Last year, almost everyone from head office came out to visit us
 - This year, we are going to invite head office staff back and get them involved in activities
 - Head office got a grant and will use some money to help us update our shop and build a storage shed; we will have room for some new tools

School Fee Change

- Increased German from \$10 to \$15; we had extra for a few years so lowered, but now we used that money for German resources so we put it back up to \$15
- We are looking at splitting up the options money to make it more clear for next year

Library Books

Potential Teacher Strike

- We have some information, but a lot is not known yet and won't be known for a while
- If it happen, it will be Monday October 6
 - In the days prior (72 hrs) we will be given more info from Palliser that we will share with you
- Schools will be CLOSED, but support staff may be there
- There are 50,000 teachers in Alberta, so us 12 didn't really have a say in this...
 we must do what Alberta does; we are getting our jets taken away
- We will be closed until the people at the table make a deal
- Central table decides the topics and what we bargain for, not us
- We don't see a lot of the issues in our schools but they are out there

- This is not to punish students; students will not be held back from graduating
- We don't think they will add days/hours, but they could
- Gave some details on what we are bargaining for and why

- School Fees

 - All money is used for students; everything goes back to the kids!

Report Cards

- We are used to 3 a year, but we will now be doing 2
- We are used to having a report card in 5 weeks from now, and we don't haven't been with the kids long enough to have good information
- We will have PTI Oct 30 and in March; Report cards in January and June
- You are welcome to check on your child's progress at anytime
- Parents are also welcome to come into the school anytime; we want you to know and see all the wonderful things we are doing

Improvements

- Barons School has had the least updates in all of Palliser
- Will fix:
 - Outdoor lights
 - Lines in parking lot so kids can use an area of it
 - Adding some ceiling fans upstairs to get better air flow
 - Will look into getting some portable air conditioners in the spring
- Looking at getting more German Vocab words posted around the school
 - Will have things labeled in English and German to help students learn

Catechism

- We do these everytime we have German class
- This is done in Hi German currently, but lots of kids don't understand what they are saying. Can we also do it in Low German?
- We know they need to say it in Hi at certain events, but if we also teach them in Low German, then they can also understand what they are saying, and not just repeating
- Looking at getting bibles for students to follow along with during Bible class; looking at getting them for the % classes so students can use them. They will stay at the school to be used by the oldest kids in future years too
